Kit List

EACH PERSON BRINGS:

- * Tent and tarps
- *Uniform. To be worn to camp for Opening, Sunday Scouts Own, and Closing
- *Sleeping Bag or Blankets, Pillow, Foamy or Air Mattress
- *Pyjamas or Sweats
- *2 Pairs each: Long pants and Underwear
- *3 Pairs Socks- Minimum
- *2 T-Shirts and 2 Sweatshirts
- *Bag for Dirty Clothes
- *Jacket and Rain Gear, Boots and Spare Sneakers
- *Sun Hat and Sun Screen
- *Towel, Facecloth, Soap, Comb, Toothbrush and Paste
- * Flashlight and Batteries
- *Plastic Plate, Bowl, and Mug (Metal not recommended) Dip bag to carry and store items
- *Fork, Knife, Spoon
- *Share snack -**NUT FREE** 1/2 doz servings each

PLEASE NO KNIVES, MONEY, CANDY, ELECTRONIC GAMES, T.V.'S, RADIOS, HOMEWORK, PETS, OR SIBLINGS. ABSOLUTELY NO WEAPONS PERMITTED. (INCLUDES TOY WEAPONS)

EACH COLONY TO BRING:

- *1 wagon per Eight Youth-decorated clown car
- *Basic Craft Supplies: Scissors, Glue, Felt Pens, Permanent Markers, Tape, glue sticks small
- *Camera
- *First Aid Kits
- *3 Wash Basins for dishes -To be handed in upon arrival (mark with your group name)

- *Hand sanitizer

OPTIONAL:

- *optional: Cream for Coffee-powder is provided
 - *Campfire Blanket
 - *More spare clothes, Teddy Bear, Story book, Insect repellent, Lawn chairs, Frisbee, Ball, Sunglasses, Binoculars, Hug-A-Tree whistle on a string
