What: 6th Annual Kub Kar Rally

When: Friday, April 13th, 2012

Where: Langley Secondary School, 21405 56th Ave, Langley, B.C.

Who: ALL registered Cubs in the Nicomekl Area are eligible to race. This is an official event, so all Cubs and leaders must be in uniform. Each entrant can race &/or show only one vehicle, unless they are racing a second Kar for a friend who could not make it.

Registration: All registration forms should be filled out in the excel spreadsheet and emailed back to Lisa (thesteppensclan@shaw.ca) by Mar. 15, 2012 at the latest. Money is also due March 15th at Scouters' Club. The cost is **\$5.00 per Cub** and **\$2.50 for extra crests**.

Tracks: We are looking for groups that can supply Kub Kar Tracks. If you can please let Julian Rogers know ASAP (604-533-5237). All tracks will need to be on site at 5:30 for set up. Last year we were short one track so any help in this area would be greatly appreciated.

Qualifying Kub Kars: Each kar must be labeled with the **youth's name, group and age category** when handed in. Kars can be brought to Scouter's Club on Mar 15th. If you are unable to bring the Kars to Scouter's Club, please call Julian Rogers – directly at 604-533-5237 to make your own arrangements. **All kars MUST be handed in by April 1st, 2012. NO kars will be accepted after this date.** If a kar is not handed in IT WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO RACE!!

Participants should have their car weighed prior to being handed in. We will be re-weighing all the Kars on one digital scale, and color-coding them as per their age division (1st, 2nd, 3rd year). **Maximum weight is 142 grams.** *There will be no lubing of the wheels - graphite and/or liquid lubricants on race night. The youths' cars will be disqualified.*

Racing information: As racers arrive, they should report to their contact leader for their race forms and track location. One Leader should put the cars on the appropriate racing tracks for preparation for judging. We do not want youth in the track area until after the judging. Cars will remain at the track. All races are to be run by specified officials. **UNIFORMED LEADERS ARE THE ONLY ADULTS THAT WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE FLOOR BEFORE THE RACING BEGINS.**

Each participant shall race approximately 15 races. Officials will tally races on race forms. Upon completion of 15 races (approx.), the official will hand in his / her race form to be tallied by computer to determine winners. Youths will take a seat in the audience once they have completed their races

Leader Races: Any Leader wishing to build and race a kar will be able to after the youth have finished their races and we are waiting for the youth tally sheets to be completed for final race offs. This will be an elimination race.

Trophies and Rosettes for Races: Rosettes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in each of the 3-age divisions. The 3 top Cub winners (1st place winners from each Cub age division) will race-off against one another to determine the overall winners, 1st, 2nd and 3rd of this year's Kub Kar Rally. Trophies will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place overall for those 3 cubs.

Best Design Competition: Best design will be judged prior to the commencement of racing. 1st, 2nd & 3rd place rosette ribbons will be awarded for the 3 age groups.

The Pit: Repairs only will be allowed to go to the pits. **NO TWEAKING.**
